'Looking at Townscapes'

These four workshops will focus on tackling the subject of buildings, streets and the urban environment using both drawing and painting. We will look for the aesthetic in many different urban subjects including figures but keep the portraying of them straightforward and uncomplicated. Forget the mathematical instruments, perspective will be tackled by simple assessment and rules of thumb with the emphasis on just getting buildings and figures 'to just look right'
